

ACROSS

- Author of "Common Sense" and "The American Crisis" who persuaded many colonists to support the cause of independence
- A secret society of colonial patriots originally formed in opposition to the Stamp Act
- Volunteer militia members capable of acting at "a minute's warning"
- Author of the Declaration of Independence; on the \$2 bill
- A religious movement that swept through the colonies beginning in the 1730s
- A gifted speaker who was known as "the champion of liberty"; he famously said, "Give me liberty or give me death."
- Group of delegates from the American colonies that served as the rebel colonial government during the American Revolution
- War of colonial independence fought between 1776-1783

DOWN

- Founding father that commanded the Continental Army; on the \$1 bill
- An event where the Sons of Liberty destroyed thousands of dollars worth of British tea
- An agreement reached by Puritans on their way to the New World; it first introduced the principle of selfgovernment in the colonies
- Founding father that was a writer, scientist, inventor, politician, and visionary; on the \$100 bill
- America's ally during the American Revolution, it would be inspired to have its own revolution in 1789
- Document written in 1215 that guaranteed certain rights to British nobles
- An event resulting in the deaths of five American protesters; it helped to encourage anti-British sentiment in the colonies
- Mother country of the American colonies, it lost control of them when it lost the American Revolution
